REFLECTIONS

Matthew 13:3-9

- Have you ever sat through a sermon or devotion and afterward, had no idea what was said?
- Do you hear plenty of talk about the Lord, but it rarely seems to "sink in?"
- Have you ever heard or read or experienced something you've experienced a thousand times before, but all of a sudden, it took on new meaning, or looked different to you?
- Have you ever had an "emotional high" in your faith - maybe at a retreat or camp? Maybe you decided to make big changes in your life? What happened to the "feeling" when you returned to normal life?
- Have you ever been asked to give your time to get involved with something you really believed in, but then your schedule got in the way?
- How we respond to things has a great deal to do with the state of our hearts. Jesus compared our hearts to the ground...some open and tender like garden soil, some frozen or full of rocks and weeds. What kind of surface is your heart right now?
- Jesus said we grow by having tender, open hearts to receive all the Lord has for us. Think of things that make your heart open and tender. Maybe offering to help in your home? Helping someone in need? Listening to a friend work through a problem?
- Do one of those things this week and beyond. Maybe make this part of your regular practices!
- Pray for and take actions toward having a heart that's open to all the Lord has for you.
